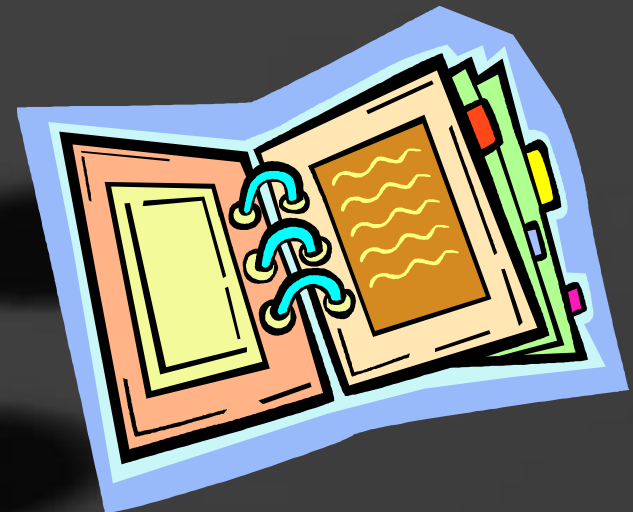

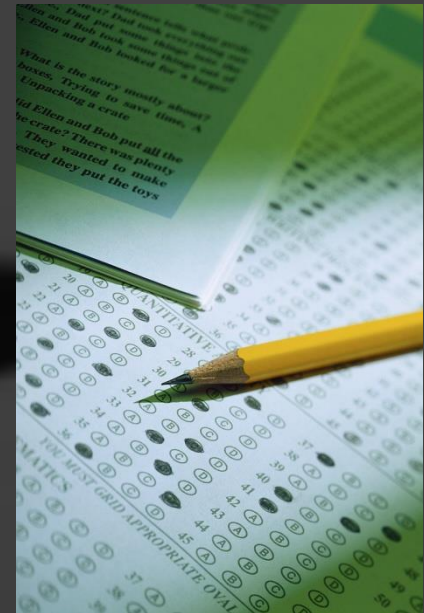

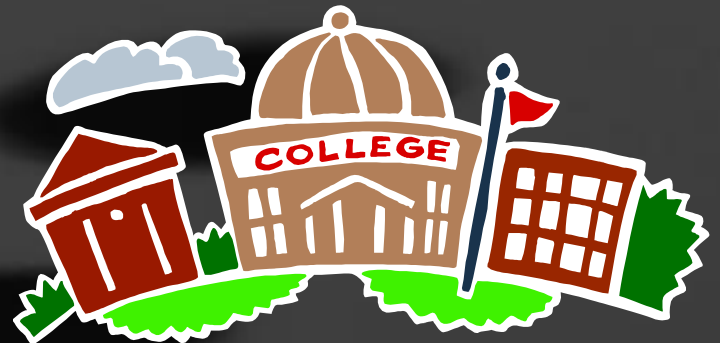
Admission Tests
