What is an Internship?

This provides participants with an opportunity to learn about career or industry by working for an employer in a field of interest over a period of time. It is a form of experiential learning, often tied to a program of study, which enables participants to gain applied experience, build professional and technical skills, and make connections in a field of interest. Placements vary, but typically include a minimum of 2 hrs./school day. Students will receive credit for the Internship.

Some main Points:

- Full year internship (Aug-June)/ can be for a semester only ½ a year if that works best
- Unpaid or Paid – we are looking for the “experience” 1st
- 10 hours a week is our goal with flexibility in how student get those hours / can be more than 10 hours too if agreed by all parties
- Student are working for credits
- HSE Schools has insurance coverage for students
- There will be support and follow up from HSE schools
