SPELL BOWL Spelling with a team approach! Spell Bowl consists of 10 players with alternates. Students who really want to challenge themselves can compete as individuals as well as team members, for a chance to compete at the state level. This is for students who are good spellers, or who want to become better spellers through practice. Competition season runs from August to November.

QUIZ BOWL Quiz Bowl is open to grades 9 – 12. Contest content includes history, literature, science, fine arts, current events, culture, sports and more!

Quiz Bowl is made up of both a varsity and junior varsity team – four players per team. These teams then compete against other schools several times a year including:
