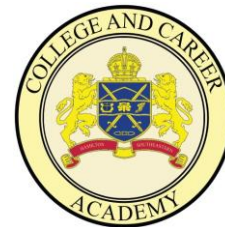

## 2022-23 IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT FOR ALL 9<sup>TH</sup> - 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADERS

Dear Parents/Guardian,

The State of Indiana has requirements for Seniors for the 2022-23 school year that may affect your student attending the upcoming school year. The Indiana code requires students in 12<sup>th</sup> grade to provide documentation of the following:

- **Two doses Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine (if their first MCV4 vaccine was given before the age of 16. Students who received the first MCV4 vaccine on or after their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday have met the requirements.**
- **Two doses of Hepatitis A (Hep A) vaccine (at least one is required by start of school year)**

We highly recommend that you talk with your child's health care provider to see if your child will need to receive the vaccinations before the beginning of the 2021-22 school year.

If your child does receive the MCV4 or Hep A vaccine, please provide documentation to your student's school nurse so that the immunization information can be added to his/her health file. If your student has exemption for vaccinations currently, this does not pertain to your student. If you choose not to vaccinate your student, an exemption form or letter must be completed. The clinic needs an exemption for vaccination form or letter completed and on file prior to the start of school.

**Any student who does not provide documentation of the required immunizations to his/her school will not be allowed to attend school in the Fall until updated immunization information has been provided.**

## Required Immunizations

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) requires certain immunizations for all students enrolled in an accredited school each year. **We highly recommend you check your students' vaccination record in Skyward Family Access, then talk with your health care provider** to see if your student needs to receive any of the vaccinations listed below. Vaccinations should be completed or started before the beginning of the school year. You may also reach out to the Fishers Health Department for assistance and administration of required immunizations ([Immunizations & Clinic Services](#))

*\*If your student has a Religious or Medical Exemption on file, in accordance with IC 20-34-3. This form MUST be completed and turned in yearly.*

Please provide documentation of updated immunizations to his/her school as soon as possible. Students who are not up to date with immunizations may not attend school until proof of vaccination.

**\*\*Please note, students going into 6<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade require updated vaccines\*\***
